

LOSSA GIRLS GOLF PLAYING REGULATIONS 2025 - 2026

The Wilson Paterson LOSSA High School Championship (revised June 2019)

Classification: Girls

- 1. The Rules of Golf as approved by Golf Canada, R&A Rules Limited, and The United States Golf Association will govern the play on Championship day. A jury of appeal will be available to deal with any problems.
- 2. The location of the Championship must be at least 5000 yards and a minimum par 70.

Format Girl's Stroke Play:

- Day 1: Shot gun start
 - Cut for Day 2 participation, top 72 golfers and ties only. Scores on the first day over 130 will not make the cut.
- Day 2: Crossover
 - Format maybe changed by the convenors if participation numbers do not warrant the above outline.
- 3. A coaches meeting will be held on the day of the Championship to determine any special playing rules due to the conditions on the day of the Championship.
- 4. A school is allowed to bring any number of female golfers. These golfers should be COMPETITIVE and not golfing for their first time at the Championship.
- 5. There will be an individual championship. There will be an open division and high school division.
 - A student-athlete who has competed in a championship governed by a provincial, state or national body within the past twelve (12) months outside of the high school program, shall be classified as an "open" participant within the individual division.
- 6. The top three (3) individual scores in both the open and high school division will receive LOSSA medals. The top individual will receive a LOSSA banner.
 - In the event of a tie, where possible, a sudden victory playoff will occur for the individual championship on a hole(s) determined by the convenor. If not possible the winner will be determined by retrogression.
- 7. Each group will have a teacher marshal who will record the scores of the players in their group. Only the marshal's card will be attested by all the members of the group. The marshal's card will be submitted to the scoring table.
- 8. LOSSA will send golfers to the OFSAA Golf Festival based on the OFSAA qualification requirements.



- 9. Coaching will not be permitted by anyone on the course.
- 10. No electronic devices are permitted on the course by competitors; including but not limited to, MP3 players, cell phones **with the exception of** distance finders.
