WASHROOM facilities will be available within the main ski chalet.

Race course: The course is challenging with beautiful groomed trails and various elevation changes. It is 75% grass with 24% dirt trail and <1% pavement. 7-9mm spikes would be suitable.

Awards: T-Shirts to the top 3 in each race as well as ribbons to the top 3 teams in each race. A KING AND QUEEN OF THE MOUNTAIN CROWN will be awarded to the OVERALL TEAM WINNER. (10 pts – 1st place, 8pts – 2nd place, 6pts – 3rd place, 5pts – 4th place, 4pts – 5th place, 3pts – 6th place, 2pts – 7th place and 1pt – 8th place).

Relays: Teams will be coed per age category (2 girls minimum per team). The course will be the 1km starting loop using the same finish as all the other races. The exchange will take place at the finish line. Costumes encouraged, but not mandatory. Runners will not be permitted to wear a mask that impedes their vision. Coaches are encouraged to race with their senior teams.
