## LOSSA BOYS FIELD LACROSSE PLAYING REGULATIONS 2023-2024

(June 2011)

## Classification: Varsity

## Playing Classification: A/AA and AAA/AAAA

Teams within each division play each other once in regular season if numbers within each division allow; OR if number of 2A teams is below 4 the following applies:
Teams divided into one of two pools; play each other within each pool; crossover to determine playoff position.

## Official Rules:

LOSSA will follow Ontario High School Field Lacrosse Rules governed by International Field Lacrosse.

## Exceptions:

1. Length of Game in regular season:
a) Four 12 minute quarters running time with 1 minute between quarters and 5 minutes between halves.

- Doubleheader games (teams play twice in one time frame)
- Four 10 minute quarters straight time with 1 minute between quarters and 5 minutes between halves.
b) Ties shall be settled by overtime which shall consist of one - 4 minute running time period with 5 minutes between regular time and the overtime. If the score is tied at the end of regulation time in a league game, each team will be awarded 1 point each. If a team scores in the overtime period, that team receives an extra 1 point.

2. Fouls:
a) A player committing 4 personal fouls or 5 minutes in personal fouls whichever comes first in the game will be suspended for the remainder of the game.
b) Fighting or Intent to Injure - Both of these are expulsion penalties.

- The players involved are suspended from the game and the next 2 league games.


## Competition:

## Regular season 2 way tie:

- result of head to head competition between tied teams


## Regular season 3 way tie:

- result of head to head competition between tied teams
- if still tied - point differential in head to head competition between tied teams
- if still tied - fewest points against in head to head competition between tied teams

Playoffs:
2A: 1 vs $4 ; 2$ vs 3 ; winners play for LOSSA 2A Championship
3A: Top 6 teams qualify for playoffs.
Quarters : $1^{\text {st }}$ and $2^{\text {nd }}$ get a bye 3 vs 64 vs 5
Semis: 1 vs lowest remaining survivor 2 vs remaining survivor Quarters, semis and finals consist of one game each.

Playoff Overtime:

- 2-4 minute running time periods
- if tied at end of $1^{\text {st }}, 2^{\text {nd }} 4$ minute overtime runs
- if tied at end of $2^{\text {nd }}$ overtime, play continues with sudden death play
- 1 timeout per team per overtime

LOSSA CHAMPION in each division will be the representative at the OFSAA Festival High School Championships.
